Standards for Plowing of private roads. Adopted 1972

- 1. Roadways must have a width of 18' with 3' shoulders and an area for winging back snow banks. The Town or its contractors will not be held responsible for property in the roadway or adjacent to the roadway in the area required for pushing back snow banks.
- 2. Roadway must be free of obstructions with a properly maintained surface. (i.e. smoothly graded or paved)
- 3. Road surface must be adequate to support heavy plowing vehicles. Muddy or soft roads cannot be plowed.
- 4. A turning area adequate for large plow vehicles must be provided. This area must allow for snow storage and turning and maneuvering area. This area cannot include driveways.
- 5. Roadway must have a minimum of two properties and have year round residents.
- 6. Roadway must be free of trees, shrubs, and branches that may damage or impede plowing vehicles.
- 7. Property owners and or Road Assoc. must grant an acknowledgement of a public easement. (added 1990 on advice of counsel)
